Luke 11:45-54

In a justice system, evidence must be presented in order to convict a defendant. Witnesses are called, evidence collected and presented to a jury. It is this jury of one's peers who decides the guilt or innocence of the one accused.

If you were on trial for being a Christian, would there be sufficient evidence to convict you? Who could testify to the fact that you know and serve Jesus? What kind of evidence from your life would be produced to prove you are a follower of Christ? What would you say on the witness stand?
