Romans 5:12-21

Adam sinned and we all have sinned. Oh, don't blame Adam or Eve. If they had not, you or I would have. I would not want the blame for that, so I am glad they did it first.

However, it is what Jesus did that makes all the difference. For by his death and resurrection we are restored because his grace overflows to us all. Through Christ God completed his plan for mankind to be restored to the state of holiness, righteousness, and purity that Adam first knew in the garden. Where Adam failed, Jesus succeeded.
