03/04/14 - The Fear of the Lord

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Psalm 111:1-10

Most people would probably define "fear" as a negative feeling. For example, I fear spiders and snakes. Other people may fear receiving bad news from their doctor. However, fear may also be viewed as a positive emotion in our lives. "The fear of the LORD is the beginning of wisdom" (Psalms 111:10)

In this, the first of several "hallelujah" Psalms, we see fear mentioned as a positive thing. Consider your parents. We typically love our parents. However, there may have been times when we feared them because of our bad behavior. We knew that they loved us and desired to protect us.
