1 Thessalonians 1:1-10

Twelve teenage girls and the ship's captain head out for a weeklong educational cruise to Catalina Island, located twenty-six miles off the coast of Southern California. They were not expecting to experience the strong winds that pushed against the bow of the 48-foot sloop carrying them to their destination. Novice sailors at best, their training as Sea Scouts was quickly put to the test as they tried to obey the orders of the captain: "Hold the line tight", "Stay the course!" They safely navigated through the storm and on to their island destination.
