1 Corinthians 15:1-11

Grief, like winter, is ushered in unwelcome and uninvited. Though we cannot die of grief, it certainly feels as if we can. However, I believe in a God whose Word says, "I am he who will sustain you. I have made you and I will carry you" (Isaiah 46:4b).
