After the healing, as the crowd gathered in amazement, Peter immediately rejected any honor for himself and gave God all the praise in an impromptu sermon where he explained it was faith in the name of Jesus that healed the man. He wasn't afraid to confront non-Christians and condemn their actions, but he gave them hope when he told them to "repent, then, and turn to God, so that your sins may be wiped out" (Acts 3:19a).
