Psalm 25:1-12

As a teenager, when I would go out with friends, my mother would offer this reminder: "Remember who you are." I knew what she meant. As I faced various choices over the course of the evening, she wanted to remind me that every choice I made would either enhance our family or hurt it.

The Psalmist recognizes this as well. He recognizes that he has not been as faithful in his actions toward God as he should have been, and he has not consistently honored God's name.
