Hebrews 4:9-16

Long ago, when my boys were young, after a rainy day, they'd begged to go outside. "You can go outside," we told them, "but stay out of the puddles." That was like telling the sun not to rise the next day. Like straight pins drawn to a magnet, they were drawn to the mud. They couldn't help it. It was mud. They are boys. They rolled, frolicked, skipped and hopped. When done, they were covered head-to-toe in mud. Never have two boys been muddier.
