Hebrews 11:1-6

The interpreter's tongue froze as he tried to comprehend the statement of the preacher that morning in chapel: "If God does not do as He says, then His name is at stake." Finally, the interpreter explained what he felt the words meant. The students came one by one to the altar and recommitted their lives to the service of the Lord. They accepted the challenge to offer themselves in faith to God's call.
