Paulâ??s â??whateverâ?• was not the passive-aggressive response of rebellious youth, but the steadfast statement of faith by a seasoned saint. His â??whateverâ?• stood firm (1:8). Paul saw what happened to him had â??really served to advance the gospelâ?• (1:12). He said, â??Because of my chains, most of the brothers and sisters have become confident in the Lord and dare all the more to proclaim the gospel without fear (1:14, TNIV).
