Luke 1:39-56

God is relentless in our redemption. Only a God of holy love would persist in the face of such obstinate rebellion. The prophet Hosea pictured God as a jilted husband, abandoned by an unfaithful and immoral wife. "I will betroth you to me forever; I will betroth you in righteousness and justice, in love and compassion. I will betroth you in faithfulness, and you will acknowledge the LORD" (2:19-20). God is not backing down.
