Acts 7:9-19

Stephen stood falsely accused of â??blasphemy against Moses and against Godâ?• (6:11<u>b</u>). He reminded his accusers of Godâ??s faithfulness to their ancestors, including Joseph. His brotherâ??s rabid jealousy led him to be sold as a slave into Egypt. Later Joseph reflected, â??But God sent me ahead of you to preserve for you a remnant on earth and to save your lives by a great deliveranceâ?• (Gen. 45:7). Jacobâ??s family was preserved through severe famine by Godâ??s advance provision of a place of safety.

Time upon time Godâ??s grace runs ahead of peopleâ??s willful disbelief. Stephenâ??s hearers were complicit in the crucifixion of Jesus Christ. Soon they would stain their hands with Stephenâ??s blood as well. Why would God grant deliverance to such murderous and unbelieving people?

Saul guarded the cloaks of those who stoned Stephen. Later he would write, a??But God demonstrates his own love for us in this: While we were still sinners, Christ died for usa?• (Rom. 5:8).
