RG102511Numbers 13:26-33

Refusing to trust God is the essence of sin. Adam and Eve's sin in the Garden of Eden was not as much the result of disobedience to God's command as it was a failure to trust in what God said. Trust can be established by one event or several consecutive events. However, once that trust is broken by a failure on the part of the one trusted it can take a lifetime to repair.

Joshua and Caleb were drawing upon a large reservoir of events in their experience with God. They had never seen God fail. They were convinced they had made the right choice and would stand with God to the end.
