Saul of Tarsus had been a terrorist. He voted to put the deacon Stephen to death (Acts 7:60^b). He went from house to house and “dragged off men and women and put them in prison” (Acts 8:3^b). He even received permission from the high priest to go to Damascus, arrest disciples, and bring them back to Jerusalem as prisoners. He was a fanatic!
