But I almost always run across stories of people doing things I can't even imagine. A wife hiring someone to kill her husband, teen boys beating their elderly neighbor. Sometimes I walk away from the news terrified! Other times, I feel pretty self-righteous that I'm not like those crazies out there!

That comes to mind as I read Romans 3. This scripture, of course, reminds us of our natural bent to sin and of the need to accept our Savior's sacrifice. But it also serves as a good reminder not to get selfrighteous. Maybe I've never robbed a neighbor, stolen a car, or done some of those other things, but I've still disobeyed God and needed his forgiveness and salvation.
