On the banks of the Red Sea, Moses encouraged the Israelites to â??Stand firm and you will see the deliverance the LORD will bring . . .â?• (Exod. 14:13b) In the Hebrew Psalter we read â??. . . he set my feet on a rock and gave me a firm place to standâ?• (Ps. 40:2b).

C. S. Lewis writes: â??Only those who try to resist temptation know how strong it is . . . You find out the strength of a wind by trying to walk against it, not by lying down. A man who gives in to temptation after five minutes simply does not know what it would have been like an hour later . . . We never find out the strength of the evil impulse inside us until we try to fight it: and Christ, because he was the only man who never yielded to temptation, is also the only man who knows to the full what temptation meansâ??the only complete realist.â?•*
