James 1:19-27

The Hebrew word translated "hear" is the same word also translated "obey." In Hebrew thought to hear God is to obey. If you did not obey the voice of the Lord, it must have been because you did not hear him. The English language recognizes a difference between hearing clear instruction and acting upon it.

As pastor of the Jerusalem church, James must have come to realize that people don't always obey the commands of God that they clearly hear. Something rooted in the sinful nature tends to distrust God. Like Adam and Eve, we may know what God has forbidden but chose to take the risk and disobey. Yet God who loves us commands and guides for our good and well-being. Failure to obey him always results in some form of loss to us.
