

Life-Changing Faith

John 6:22-40

When the disciples asked Jesus what works God was expecting of them, they were expecting a long list that they could use as a daily barometer to see how they were measuring up in this new life of faith. They were surprised to find that the checklist Jesus gave them had just one point: “Believe in the one he has sent.”

The word “believe” is an action verb. The disciples asked for a work to do, a job to be done, and Jesus tells them to “believe.” On the surface it may seem like an easy task. It’s not hard to believe in Jesus. Evidence of his life, death, and resurrection are everywhere. In the case of the disciples, Jesus was physically present. They could see him and touch him. But somehow our belief must work its way into action.

An active belief in Jesus Christ will change the way you think and the way you act. Your heart and passion will be exposed by your actions. How has your belief in Jesus changed the way you live?
