Ephesians 2:1-10

One of the most disastrous misconceptions about Christianity is the idea that Godâ??s favor is earned: that, when the judgment comes, as long as oneâ??s list of â??goodâ?• deeds is longer than the â??bad,â?• then all will be well.

This could not be further from the truth. Such a belief is not found in Scripture. Paul assures us, â??For it is by grace you have been saved, through faithâ??and this is not from yourselves, it is the gift of Godâ??not by works, so that no one can boastâ?• (Eph. 2:8-9; emphasis added). Godâ??s grace is a gift we cannot buy.
