Acts 3:11-26

When Jesus changes lives, people notice. Those at the temple were astonished by the healing of the lame man. Peter was quick to say heâ??d been healed by faith in the name of Jesus. Then Peter began to preach. Like a prosecuting attorney, he charged them with Jesusâ?? death. â??You handed him over to be killedâ?• (v. 13). â??You killed the author of lifeâ?• (v. 15). They had no defense.
