But it is also the â??disciplinedâ?• (2:5) path we follow in our daily walk with Christ. Along the journey of faith we enjoy the blessings of present-salvation: â??love . . . for all Godâ??s peopleâ?• (1:4; see 2:2), fruitful lives (1:6, 10), increasing understanding of Godâ??s will, Spirit-empowerment to do it (1:11), joyful thanksgiving to the Father (1:12), rescue â??from the dominion of darkness,â?• life in â??the kingdom of the Sonâ?• (1:13), â??redemptionâ?•â??real freedom, â??forgiveness of sinsâ?• (1:14), reconciliationâ??friendship with God (1:22), and Christ in us (1:27).

Faith is goal-oriented. It has a direction and a destination. Our journey leads us toward increasing maturity in Christ (1:28), lives â??worthy of the Lord [that] please him in every wayâ?• (1:10).
