

Godâ??s Broken Heart

Amos 4:1-13

Amos, chapter 4, seems harsh. â??The time will surely come,â?• God tells His people, â??when you will be taken away with hooks, the last of you with fishhooksâ?• (4:2). A terrible image! It gets worse: â??I gave you empty stomachs in every cityâ?• (v. 6). â??I sent plagues among youâ?• (v. 10). â??I killed your young menâ?• (v. 10).

Verse 4 gives us a clue as to why God was so angry with His people: â??Go to Bethel and sin; go to Gilgal and sin yet more. . . . This is what you love to doâ?• (vv. 4-5). Five times in these 13 verses, God says, â??yet you have not returned to meâ?• (vv. 6, 8, 9, 10, 11). Do you hear the heartbreak in Godâ??s voice? God had given His people ample opportunity to turn from their sins, but they would not. Even when disasters befell them, they did not examine their lives to see if they could be the cause of their own misery.

Even when we turn our backs on God, He will go to great lengths to recapture our attention. This is a great and redemptive love!
