Our family enjoys table games. We build memories as we move game pieces or match images on a board. Some games have timers that wind down, and then there is a moment of silence before the timer makes a loud noise. The player's turn is over.

Some players view the timer as their enemy. The timer paralyzes them as they listen to the tick, tick, tick. To them it says, "You are small. You can't do anything. You won't survive." Their hands shake, and their mind goes blank. Opposing players don't have to worry. Their competitor will take his turn without moving one space for himself or his team.
