What came out of the silence shows us who Zechariah listened to when he was silenced. It was clear that Zechariah heard from God because God was all he sang about.

It's easy to live in the noise that makes us believe it is past time for God's promises to come true. Sometimes it requires times of silence to recognize that God did more than just think about coming to us. He came. God, creator and owner of this earth, eternally alive in a world our eyes have not been opened to see, figured out how to bridge the distance that we often don't even understand.
