Psalm 19:1-14

Can you remember how many skinned knees, cuts, or bruises you got as a kid? No? I can't either. It's likely, however, that we can recall hurtful words we have received through the years. Words can carry a lasting punch.

- God uses words to create. Light and life originate from the mighty proclamation, "Let there be" (Gen. 1:3, 6).
- God uses words to call. "Do not be afraid, Abram. I am your shield, your very great reward" (Gen. 15:1).
- God uses words to condemn. "Take your evil deeds out of my sight; stop doing wrong. Learn to do right; . . . I will turn my hand against you" (Isa. 1:16b-17a, 25a).
