Mark 9:14-27

They have been recording only half of your electricity usage. We will work with you to care for the accumulated \$25,000 bill." Everyone on the board was in shock (the pun is intended!).

On Wednesday night and Sunday morning he simply invited the people to trust, pray, and fast intentionally that God would provide.
