John 2:1-12

Much has been written about Christâ??s first recorded miracleâ??the changing of water into wine at the wedding at Cana. If one reads the account with fresh eyes, it seems natural to wonder what His mother knew about Him, and what she didnâ??t know.

In the approximately 30 years she had known Him, had Jesusâ?? mother ever seen Him turn water into wine? Were there earlier weddings in which the Lord enhanced the buffet? Unlikely.

The truth is: we donâ??t have any biblical evidence to suggest that Jesus had performed miracles before this point or that His mother had observed Him doing so. In fact, His comment that â??â??My hour has not yet comeâ??â?• in John 2:4b may specify that He hadnâ??t.

So why was Mary confident that Jesus could redeem this situation?

It may be as simple as the fact that, because she knew Him, she trusted Him. She may not have known what He would do or how He would do it. But the beauty of it is; she probably didnâ??t care. Perhaps she had simply learned that doing what He said was always the right decision no matter the circumstance. Maybe thatâ??s the best definition of trust.
