Leviticus 19:1-18

Leviticus 19 is a collection of sundry laws, both ethical and ceremonial, and sound familiar to the Ten Commandments in Exodus 20. Of the 18 verses, 8 caution the reader, "I am the LORD your God." This must have been a very important point for the assembly of Israel to remember.
