Genesis 3:1-19

God created Adam, then Eve, in His own image. He placed them in a perfect world and gave them divine direction on what was right and wrong. Before long, Satan approached Eve with the question, "Did God really say, 'You must not eat from any tree in the garden'?" (v. 1).
