Deuteronomy 32:28-43

Israel confessed the right faith but often lived by a different theology. When trouble and suffering came, they wondered whether the Lord was real and whether He cared about them. As a result, while they continued to affirm right beliefs about God, they also sought the help of the gods of the nations. Perhaps they thought, “Why take any chances? There are many roads that lead to the same blessings—health, wealth, security, support, and happiness.”

Sometimes we also are tempted along these lines. We know the truth and trust God, but we also know that we are responsible to take action. Instead of acting in faith, we attempt to look out for ourselves. As accurate as our confessions of faith may be, our lives may be driven by other beliefs.
