Galatians 3:1-14

A writer recalled his grandmother's devotion to her church. Would it merit her some important job in heaven such as, "mending clouds"? God is not recruiting people to do upkeep work on the New Jerusalem. The Creator can just say one word and things will be neatly fixed. His purpose is much higher for those He seeks to recruit: "so that by faith we might receive . . . the Spirit" (3:14). This is not a wish for a distant tomorrow, but for this very day.
