Joel 2:21-32

Joel 2 relates to the coming Messianic period. God promises those who remain true to Him a special outpouring of His Spirit. Peter saw its fulfillment in the outpouring of the Holy Spirit on Pentecost; "This is what was spoken by the prophet Joel" (Acts 2:16). God promises in Joel 2:27, "Then you will know that I am in Israel, that I am the Lord your God." God promises His care to those who trust in Him.

The story is told of a poor man who heard singing in the Temple and he went in, prostrated himself on the floor, and worshipped. Other people brought their offerings, but he had none.
