Acts 3:1-10

In Exodus 17, we read of the Israelites' first battle on the way to the Promised Land. As they fought, they had to work together, and each player had a significant role: Joshua led the physical battle, while Aaron and Hur provided the support Moses needed to maintain the supernatural advantage. As long as Moses held up the staff of God, the Israelites prevailed. When Moses grew weary, Aaron and Hur held his arms up.
