In characteristic swagger, he grabbed the spotlight and proclaimed himself “the Greatest.” Then, in a February 1978 match considered one of the biggest upsets in boxing history, Muhammad Ali, the “Undisputed Champion of the World” was defeated by Leon Spinks, a relative newcomer. Expecting to win handily, Ali had lightened his training regimen and was ill-prepared for the battle.
