Romans 10:1-13

A prominent Pharisee came to Jesus with an unspoken question: "How does one enter the kingdom of God?" (John 3:1-8). A wealthy young man asked, "What good thing must I do to get eternal life?" (Matthew 19:16). A Philippian jailer asked Paul and Silas, "What must I do to be saved?" (Acts 16:29). They might have all asked, "How can I be right with God?"
