John 18:28-38

Pilate didnâ??t want to decide about Jesus. Why were these pesky Judeans bringing this man to him anyway? Was this a trap? â??If he were not a criminal . . . we would not have handed him over to you,â?• they said (v. 30). But what were the charges? Roman law demanded charges. Pilate already suspected what the charge would be: â??â??Are you the king of the Jews?â?? â??Is that your own idea,â?? Jesus asked, â??or did others talk to you about me?â??â?• (vv. 33-34). The charge of insurrection, if proven, would lead inevitably to a cross.

â??My kingdom is not of this world,â?• was Jesusâ?? reply (v. 36). You cannot find it on a map. Jesusâ?? kingdom is in the hearts of those who call Him â??Lord.â?• A king rules where he is acknowledged, where his law is obeyed and his sovereignty acclaimed. Jesus is a king, whether Pilate, Caesar, the Jewish leaders or any other authority acknowledges it.

â??I find no basis for a charge against him,â?• Pilate told the leaders (v. 38). Ultimately, he did have to decide, and so do we all. Not just â??Is Jesus a king?â?• but â??Is Jesus your King?â?•
