1 Kings 21:15-29

To understand the fury that is leveled toward Queen Jezebel and King Ahab, we must go back and read 1 Kings 18. In verse 4, we read that Queen Jezebel was persecuting and â??killing off the LORDâ??s prophetsâ?• (v. 4). With this, we can begin to understand the Lordâ??s shocking judgment on her: â??Dogs will devour Jezebel by the wall of Jezreelâ?• (21:23).

Ahabâ??s choices as king of Israel reaped the deserved consequences. Because Ahab â??sold [himself] to do evil in the eyes of the LORDâ?• (v. 20), he and his descendants were to be cut off from the land of the living. What happened next is an example of human contrition and Godâ??s forgiveness: â??When Ahab heard these words, he tore his clothes, put on sackcloth and fasted. He lay in sackcloth and went around meeklyâ?• (v. 27).

What is your response to Godâ??s conviction of sin? Once again, choices bring consequences. The choice is yoursâ??to humbly submit your life to the Lord or continue in sin.
