Acts 15:22-35

Solomon wrote, “A word fitly spoken is like apples of gold in settings of silver” (Proverbs 25:11, NKJV). The right word, said at the right time, with the right tone is indeed very precious. It is a healing balm, the spark that lights a fire in a dark place, or the inspiration to take another step forward.

We don't know the words that the two prophets in Acts 15 spoke to the Gentile believers in Antioch, but we know the outcome: the people were encouraged and strengthened.
