Romans 1:18-32

Romans 1 highlights that since the beginning of time, God has clearly made himself known—through nature, through Scripture, through our consciences, in our hearts, and through His prophets. We really have no excuse for not knowing Him, serving Him, and loving Him.

Let's commit to serving Him with 100 percent, so that when we stand before Him, we won't need to make any excuses.
