Proverbs 12:1-14

Television, social media, and politics thrive on character assassination and they revel in the failures of others. The hotter the scandal, the more it is covered. People used watched their words. Now however, we act as if words have no weight. The truth is that words mean things. Proverbs 12:6 reads that the "words . . . lie in wait for blood." Words meant to draw blood—hurt or injure—are never from God. On the other side, our words can be used to heal and repair damage.
