If he does not go away, he will not be able to send the Counselor, the one who will help the disciples proclaim the gospel.

This promise of the Holy Spirit was especially important because Jesus has just assured his disciples that their path would not be easy: they would experience the same kinds of persecutions because they were associated with Jesus.
