Luke 5:12-20

I am not much of an athlete. I also didn't grow up in a home that participated in, watched, or talked about sports. Most of my knowledge about any sports came gym class.

While there are many things I've forgotten from all those hours spent in the school gym, there is one bit I remember: keep your eye on the ball. Have you ever heard or spoke that advice to someone?
