Hebrews 3:1-13

The Christian's race is not a sprint—it is a marathon.

The author of Hebrews calls the followers of Jesus “holy” brothers and sisters. The word “holy” in this context means separate, or set apart. Which then begs us to ask the question, “Is our focus on Jesus or are we distracted?”

How does this time with Jesus impact the way we live out the rest of our lives? Holy brothers and sisters, let us fix our thoughts on Jesus only!
