She doesn't debate whether I'll show up this time or not. She simply jumps into my arms.

Trusting God to catch you may not be easy for you. Fear can be a powerful, ugly thing. We doubt. We hesitate. We fear the worst. And yet, God is still there, waiting to take our hand and guide us. He hasn't left. Allow God to open your heart to the love that casts out fear.
