John 17:20-26

It is a common sentiment expressed in many stories through life: "we've been praying for you before we even knew who you were." It's told at wedding celebrations by parents of the bride or groom. It's recounted by church boards and congregations installing a new pastor. It's expressed by organizations inaugurating new leaders. Invariably, these partnership contexts include a hope for unity of life, vision, and mission.
