Nehemiah 6:10-19

We say of someone who has had success and achieved a level of status, that they have “made a name for themselves.” The men in Nehemiah 6 have made a name for themselves, we read of them these many years later. However, we know that they were without honor as they intimidated and bullied the people of God.
