Proverbs 11:14-21

Words matter because they flow out of the condition of our heart. Solomon speaks to us about concealing our hatred with lies and spreading slander. Wisdom dictates not that we pretend that we do not hate, but that we acknowledge our heart is not right and we seek God's help towards transformation.
