Psalm 150:1-6

They are willing to pay money (sometimes a lot of money) for tickets, parking, and food. Many dress up in their favorite team's hat and jersey. Some may even dress up in some funny costume related to their team. People bring signs, stand, shout, clap, and cheer—leaving no doubt which team they are a fan of.
