We are a restless people. It has been estimated that Americans move an average of 11.7 times in their lives. I once pastored along the Front Range of Colorado. The town where I lived, Longmont, was a town of about 8,000 at the end of World War II. When I moved there it was home to some 45,000. Now it has nearly 100,000 residents. Many came for jobs in the growing high-tech industry. Some came to be near the beauty and recreation opportunities of the Colorado Rocky Mountains. Sadly, their old problems had a way of following them.
