Ephesians 4:17-24

Look in the mirror. What do you see? Most likely you see someone who has aged, someone with a few more grey hairs and wrinkles. Do you know what God sees when He looks at us? He sees His child. He sees glimpses of himself. Ephesians 4 reminds us to see ourselves and others with God's eyes.

When I look at my son, sometimes I am caught in moments between the past and the future. I look at him and I see the tiny month-early baby that he was, but sometimes I can also see the man he is potentially going to become. Other times I see him as he is now, a four-year-old trying to figure out himself and the world.
